Tuition

The cost for the seminar is \$2,000.00. This includes nine lectures and group coaching sessions, and five individual coaching sessions. The tuition is due before the seminar begins.

Room & Board

There is a Room & Board charge of \$1,025.00 for staying at the Roslyn Center. *This includes three nights lodging and nine meals for each of the three-day sessions.* This is payable at the beginning of the seminar. (Cab ride from the Richmond airport is about \$25 and about a half hour.)

Commuting

For those wishing to attend the seminar as a commuter, there is a commuter fee of \$193.50 for the year. This includes lunch each seminar day. Additional meals at the retreat center can be purchased ahead of time.

Format

Nine days each year feature didactic training and discussions in the morning, video at lunch, and group coaching in the afternoon. Five individual coaching sessions are included. Three-year rotating curriculum can be entered in any year, with a one year commitment at a time.
